This laboratory was officially inaugurated by Prof. Dr. Ahmad, SE., M.Si., as the Rector of Lambung Mangkurat University on January 20th, 2023, as a form of the institution's commitment to providing a collaborative and creative space to support the learning process, develop academic literacy, and improve the quality of scientific work of students and lecturers within the Social Studies Education Study Program.

3. Workshops and Training

Periodic training on scientific writing techniques, journal publications, the use of supporting applications such as Mendeley, Grammarly, Turnitin, and so on.

4. Internal Peer Review Service

Facilitate academic feedback on draft writings from peers to improve the quality of manuscripts prior to publication.

5. Scientific Publication Assistance

Guidance in the preparation of articles and the process of submission to reputable national and international journals.

6. Digital Content Creation and Management

Social media content production services for the Study Program, including manuscript writing, photo/video capture and editing, and visual design of academic promotion.

7. Creation and Publication of Activity News

Writing and editing news on academic, student, and cooperation activities, which are ready to be published in the internal campus media or the official channel of the study program.
